Update on Esperanza Gold Project

Patric Barry, President of Tiger International Resources Inc (TGR.TSXV) announces that further to previous news releases that negotiations have reached an advanced stage with the leaders of the NCIP (National Commission on Indigenous Peoples) in the local area where the Esperanza Gold Project (Expa 86) is located in the Northern Philippines.

Included in the Philippine Mining Act of 1995 is a provision that mining companies obtain the Free and Prior Informed Consent of local indigenous groups. The Philippine Government has already granted approval to Tiger International's detailed Exploration Application, and several consultation meetings with indigenous people's representatives and public meetings have been held.

Tiger's Management expected to attend a signing meeting next week in Baguio in the Northern Philippines which would have concluded the negotiations. However, a draft agreement containing unexpected new and unacceptable terms has been provided today to Tiger management, and these new terms need further negotiation. Unacceptable terms include payment of monies and loading up the board of directors of Tiger's subsidiary with NCIP representatives, issues which will impede operations and are unreasonable.

Tiger's management has chosen to make this news release so as to keep the shareholders fully informed. Alternatives open to the Company include negotiation so as to bring the NCIP agreement into realms of normalcy, or to go to Arbitration if negotiations fail. Tiger has retained the services of two expert Philippine consultants who are skilled and experienced in this work, and will be guided by those representatives.

Tiger will hold its April 30, 2007 Annual General Meeting at the offices of the Company at 26981 Highwood Circle, Laguna Hills CA 92653 at 8:30 am on June 9th, 2008.
